

OFFICIAL RULES - 2010

Join KOLR10 (Springfield), KSFM (Ft. Smith), KHTV (Little Rock) at Branson Landing in Downtown Branson, Missouri on Saturday, June 26th, 2010 from 4:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. for the Late Show with David Letterman Stupid Human Tricks & Stupid Pet Tricks Casting Call.

No purchase is necessary. This casting call is open to all ages. However, participants under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. The parent or legal guardian must chaperone and sign a release waiver. Participants will have the chance to be selected to perform their trick on the Late Show with David Letterman.

You must arrive at the casting call between 4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Casting call is based on a first come, first serve basis so pre-registration will not guarantee an audition. The last audition will take place promptly at 7:00 p.m. Please read the full casting call rules for all details.

Auditions will take place outside in front of the Branson Landing Fountains. If you are participating in the Stupid Pet Tricks Casting Call, please take note of the following: bring water for your pet, pets must be under the control of owner at all times prior to the casting call (leash, crate, etc.), and owner must provide proof of all current vaccinations.

RULES FOR LATE SHOW WITH DAVID LETTERMAN STUPID HUMAN TRICKS & STUPID PET TRICKS CASTING CALL

(a) Beginning June 26^h, 2010, people that wish to audition for LATE SHOW WITH DAVID LETTERMAN STUPID PET & HUMAN TRICKS may register. Registration will close at 7:01 p.m. CT on Saturday, June 26th, 2010.

(b) Pre-registration requires participant name, daytime phone number, email address, and brief description of the trick to be performed.

(c) One trick and registration per person and or animal.

(d) Participants must be 18 years of age or older. Minors are allowed to audition, however a parent or legal guardian must chaperone and sign a release waiver.

(e) To qualify, the trick must be fun, unique and safe. Animals must perform voluntarily and be treated humanely.

(f) LATE SHOW WITH DAVID LETTERMAN STUPID PET & HUMAN TRICKS AUDITIONS will take place at Branson Landing, Missouri on Saturday June 26th, 2010 from 4:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

(g) Release/waiver forms should be completed in advance and turned in at check-in at Branson Landing on Saturday, June 26th 2010.

(h) Check-in for LATE SHOW WITH DAVID LETTERMAN STUPID PET & HUMAN TRICKS AUDITIONS will be held in Branson Landing Town Square on Saturday, June 26, 2010. Check-in will open at 4:00 p.m. CT on Saturday, June 26, 2010 and will close at 7:00 p.m. CT on Saturday, June 26, 2010.

(i) Prior to their audition, participants must complete all release/waiver forms and provide proof of current rabies vaccination for animals requiring a current rabies vaccination (including dogs, cats and ferrets). Animals that do not have proof of current rabies vaccination will not be allowed at the Branson Landing to audition. In the case of a minor, their parent or legal guardian must complete these forms on their behalf.

(j) Walk-up registrations/auditions will be permitted but auditions will end promptly at 7:00 p.m. CT regardless of if you had a chance to audition.

(k) The last participant will be allowed to audition at 7:00 p.m.

(l) If you are unable to attend the LATE SHOW WITH DAVID LETTERMAN STUPID PET & HUMAN TRICKS AUDITIONS at Branson Landing on Saturday, June 26, 2010, you may call 1-888-PET-TRIK (1-888-738-8745) to qualify for an audition.

(m) Branson Landing will not allow the following animals: no wolves, no pet wild animals (lions, tigers, bears, raccoons, skunks, etc.), no farm animals (calves, lambs, baby goats, etc.), no snakes or lizards over 6-feet long, no venomous animals, and no animals (cats, dogs, ferrets) not providing proof of current rabies vaccination.

(n) Branson Landing and Branson Convention and Visitors Bureau has the discretion to turn away any animal that does not fit the guidelines above, or any animal that appears to be aggressive towards other people or animals.

(o) Participants selected by The LATE SHOW WITH DAVID LETTERMAN personnel will receive a free trip to New York, a payment for their appearance on the show, and a chance to perform their trick on the stage of the Ed Sullivan Theater in front of millions of LATE SHOW WITH DAVID LETTERMAN viewers.
